 Presentation by Laura Brown Breetvelt on proposed HF McLean/R Kipling monument.

Jane Graham outlined the activities that have taken place over the past couple of years regarding a bronze monument for Merrickville to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Ritual of the Calling of an Engineer, which also used Kipling's poem the Sons of Martha. This Legacy project is not going forward for a variety of reasons, although a Cairn that the Engineers wanted replicated is complete and will be placed likely in Merrickville near the water pump station on Main Street. The Committee that has been working on the project would like to move forward on a sculpture of just HF McLean and a commemorative positioning in the parkette near the Blockhouse and within sight of the Cairn. He spent 40 years in Merrickville and was engaged in interesting and substantial projects. We would like to welcome Laura Brown Breetvelt to tell us about her work on sculptures for other communities and her ideas for this project.

Laura presented some slides of various works she has done for other communities including Elliot Lake, Peterborough, Ottawa with information/educational detail at the sites, and answered questions from the membership about her process and ideas.

- Opportunity to profile McLean and Merrickville
